

HOW TO GET THERE?

ACCESS BY PLANE


To start your vacation sailing St. Martin, fly into Princess Juliana International Airport (SXM). There are regular flights from various US cities and the taxi transfer to our marina takes 30 minutes.

Grand-Case Esperance Airport (SFG) is on the French side of the island and is used mainly for regional flights from nearby Caribbean islands.

TRANSFERS FROM THE AIRPORT TO OUR BASE

If you need an organized transfer from the airport, please contact our base manager. Major car rental companies operate from the airport, please refer to the airport website for info, working hours and contacts. Taxis are regularly available in front of the airport buildings.

USEFUL INFORMATION

CURRENCY:

The currency in St. Martin is the **Euro** (EUR), but US Dollars (USD) are also accepted on both sides of the island.

INTERNET

There is internet access in many bars and restaurants throughout the cruising ground, which you can use during your St. Martin sailing charters. Cell phones can work depending on zones but don't forget the roaming fees!

ENVIRONMENT

- Respect your surroundings and leave only footprints in the sand
- Only use the engine or genset when needed (fill up your tanks for the water maker at the docks when you can)
- Recycle your garbage in the correct containers at the marina
- Respect regulations around marine reserves and private islands where disembarking is not permitted
- Spear fishing and the removal of any items from the sea while scuba diving is generally prohibited, and this is very strictly enforced in Anguilla, St. Barts and Saba in particular. Spear guns are prohibited on the Dutch side of St Maarten. On the French side spear fishing is allowed outside of the Marine Parks, but always without scuba diving gear.

YOUR CRUISE

Payment for the on-board cash register is made in cash when boarding your boat.

The optional payment for the excursion pack (if applicable) can be made to your captain in cash or by credit card at the office at the end of your cruise.

It is **essential** that each passenger must have a passport valid for **6 months after the return date**. A copy of your passports should be sent before your departure to the organizer of your cruise.
